CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

SIGNET'S POLICY:

- 1. To direct of SIGNET'S CSR Programmers, inter alia, towards achieving one or more of the following enhancing environmental and natural capital; supporting rural development; promoting education; providing preventive healthcare, providing sanitation and drinking water; creating livelihoods for people, especially those from disadvantaged sections of society, in rural and urban India; preserving and promoting sports;
- 2. To develop the required capability and self-reliance of beneficiaries at the grass roots, especially of women, in the belief that these are prerequisites for social and economic development;
- 3. To engage in affirmative action interventions such as skill building and vocational training, to enhance employability and generate livelihoods for persons from disadvantaged sections of society;
- 4. To pursue CSR Programmers primarily in areas that fall within the economic vicinity of the Company's operations to enable close supervision and ensure maximum development impact;
- 5. To carry out CSR Programmers in relevant local areas to fulfill commitments arising from requests by government/regulatory authorities and to earmark amounts of monies towards "Enterprise Social Responsibility (ESR)" activities and to spend such monies through ESR/CSR Cells of such administrative bodies of the government and/or directly by way of developmental works in the local areas around which the Company operates;
- 6. To provide equal opportunities to beneficiaries of the Company's CSR Programmers as vendors or employees on merit;

FOCUS AREAS

In accordation with the requirements under the Companies Act 2013 SIGNET CSR activities, amongst other, will focus on.

- 1. HUNGER, POWER, MALNUTRITION AND HEALTH: Eradicating extreme hunger, poverty and malnutrition ,promoting preventing healthcare and sanitation and making available safe drinking water.
- 2. EDUCATION: Promoting education, including special education and employmentsenhancing vocational skills especially among children, woman elderly and differently abled, and livelihood enhancement projects monetary contribution to academic institution for establishing endowment fund, with the objective of assisting students in their studies.
- 3. **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJRCT** : Strengthening rural areas by improving accessibility, housing, drinking water, sanitation, power and livelihood, thereby creating sustainable villages.
- 4. **ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY:** Ensuring environmental sustainability, ecological balance, protection of flora and fauna, animal welfare, agro- forestry, conservation of natural resources and maintaining the quality of soil, air and water.
- 5. NATIONAL HERITAGE, ART AND CULTURE: Protecting national heritage, art and culture including restoration of buildings and sites of historical importance and work of art, setting up public libraries; promoting and Developing traditional arts and handicraft.

Location of CSR Efforts

The CSR committee will decide on the location for CSR activities.

Governance

- 1. Every year, the CSR and Sustainability Committee will place for the Board's approval, a CSR Plan delineating the CSR Programmers to be carried out during the financial year and the specified budgets thereof. The Board will consider and approve the CSR Plan with any modification that may be deemed necessary.
- 2. The Corporate Management Committee (CMC) will assign the task of implementation of the CSR Plan within specified budgets and timeframes to such persons or bodies as it may deem fit.
- 3. The persons/bodies to which the implementation is assigned will carry out such CSR Programmers as determined by the CMC within the specified budgets and timeframes and report back to the CMC on the progress thereon at such frequency as the CMC may direct.
- 4. The CMC shall review the implementation of the CSR Programmers once a quarter and issue necessary directions from time to time to ensure orderly and efficient execution of the CSR Programmers in accordance with this Policy.
- 5. Once every six months the CMC will provide a status update to the CSR and Sustainability Committee on the progress of implementation of the approved CSR Programmers carried out during the six month period. It shall be the responsibility of the CSR and Sustainability Committee to review such reports and keep the Board apprised of the status of implementation of the same.
- 6. At the end of every financial year, the CSR and Sustainability Committee will submit its report to the Board.

<u>CSR Expenditure</u>

CSR expenditure will include all expenditure, direct and indirect, incurred by the Company on CSR Programmers undertaken in accordance with the approved CSR Plan. Moreover, any surplus arising from any CSR Programmers shall be used for CSR. Accordingly, any income arising from CSR Programmers will be netted off from the CSR expenditure and such net amount will be reported as CSR expenditure.

The Company's engagement in this domain is disseminated on its website, annual reports and its house journals as and when deem fit
